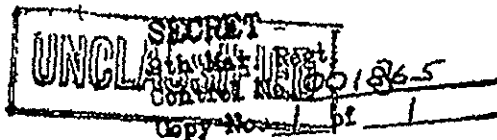

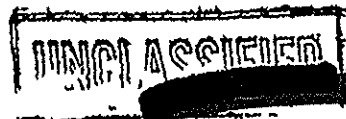

## Part II - Narrative Summary

1. BLT 1/9 embarked at White Beach, Okinawa on 19 December 1964 aboard the USS HENRICO (APA-45), the USS UNION (AKA-106) and the USS VANCOUVER (LPD-2) sailing on 21 December 1964 and arrived at the Naval Station, Subic Bay, R.P.I. on 23 December 1964. Immediately upon arrival in Subic Bay this organization exchanged shipping with BLT 3/3 embarking aboard the USS PRINCETON (LPH-5) flagship of CTG 76.5, the USS BEXAR (APA-237) and the USS THOMASTON (LSD-28). BLT 1/9 assumed the status of the Number 1 Surface BLT, Seventh Fleet, an element of Task Group 76.5 on 23 December 1964 and completed loading supplies and equipment the following day.
2. Christmas morning, 25 December 1964, Task Group 76.5 was alerted for Special Operations. By 1200 of that day TG 76.5 was underway for station off Cap St. Jacques, Republic of Vietnam. The BLT arrived on station on 27 December and was placed on a six hour reaction time with the mission of occupying and securing Tan Son Nhut (TSN) Airfield in Saigon to ensure continuation of air operation at that facility. Necessary Frag Orders were issued for the accomplishment of the assigned mission and after arrival on station several conferences were conducted with representatives of COMUSMACV in Saigon for further coordination.
3. On 7 January 1965, a practice turnaway helicopter and surface landing was conducted. During this period on station shipboard training was commenced immediately with special emphasis on helicopter operations, riot control measures and physical fitness.
4. Planning continued within 76.5 and on 12 January 1965 the CO of BLT 1/9 was conducted on an air reconnaissance of Tan Son Nhut, Bien Hoa and Vung Tau Airfields. The same day two of the BLT Company Commanders were conducted on a tour of the ground defenses of Tan Son Nhut Airfield.
5. The BLT remained on station off Cap St. Jacques until 25 January 1965 when the reaction time was changed to ninety-six hours and then the entire TG 76.5 was underway for Hong Kong. The next day, 26 January 1965, the BLT was again alerted for Special Operations and proceeded to station off Danang, Vietnam. Then on 28 January the Task Group again returned to station off Cap St. Jacques on six hour reaction time.
6. The 30th of January again saw the reaction time relaxed to ninety-six hours and the Task Group was underway to Subic Bay, P.I. Upon arrival in Subic Bay on 2 February the BLT conducted a practice helicopter and surface landing. The next several days the BLT attended to preventive maintenance and on 6 February started Jungle Training in the Subic Bay Training Area.

7. 7 February again brought the alert to the BLT for Special Operations. That day the Task Group commenced movement to station off Cap St. Jacques. On 10 February the BLT was again on station standing by on a six hour reaction time with the same mission of occupying and securing TSN Airfield, Saigon. Shipboard training continued with general military subjects training with emphasis on physical conditioning. On 27 February the reaction time was again moved back to ninety-six hours and the Task Group proceeded to Subic Bay arriving on 2 March.

8. For the next several days the BLT conducted preventive maintenance and prepared for relief as Number 1 Surface BLT. On 7 March BLT 2/9 relieved BLT 1/9 as Number 1 Surface BLT and BLT 1/9 off loaded from the Number 1 Surface BLT shipping.

9. Upon off loading on 7 March the BLT loaded aboard Landing Ship Squadron Nine (six LSTs) for the return to Okinawa. Loading was completed on 8 March and the BLT was enroute to Okinawa from 9 to 12 March.

10. On the 13th of March the BLT commenced off loading at Buckner Bay and Ora Wan Beach, Okinawa. The Completion of off loading of the BLT was conducted at Naha, Okinawa on 14 March 1965.

- 26 Dec 64 Forward element of BLT 1/9 aboard USS PRINCETON arrived on station off Cap St. Jacques at 2010H on six hour reaction time. BLT 1/9 Frag Order 1-64 issued.
- 27 Dec 64 Remainder of BLT 1/9 aboard USS BEXAR and USS THOMASTON arrived on station off Cap St. Jacques.
- 28 Dec 64 CTF 76 held operation conference aboard USS PRINCETON for all Navy and Marine Commanders of TF 76. BLT 1/9 Frag Order 2-64 issued.
- 29 Dec 64 Shipboard training being conducted with special emphasis on riot control measures.
- 30 Dec 64 CO BLT 1/9 attended operation conference with COMUSMACV at Saigon as member of party from TF 76 and Ninth MEB.
- 31 Dec 64 BLT 1/9 Frag Order 3-64 issued.
