PART II: GENERAL CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS DURING REPORTING PERIOD

1. 1st Battalion conducted clear and hold operations and aggressive patrolling within the TAOR, protecting the rice crop, liberating the populace from VC control, establishing control within the zone, and killing VC enroute. This was accomplished by utilizing the maximum number of squad size patrols possible, saturating the TAOR with patrols and ambushes, both day and night, searching out and killing the VC in his havens and safe areas. Control of the TAOR was maintained by use of platoon strong points and tank-infantry-LVT task forces. Attention was also directed to the psychological warfare effort, utilizing loud-speaker helicopters, leaflet drops, and face to face persuasion. Emphasis was also placed upon the civil affairs program.

PART III: SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Personnel. Detailed personnel data is contained in the S-1 Journal submitted as a supporting document. The Battalion was involved in the Division reassignment program; 366 USMC personnel were joined and 353 were dropped and/or transferred for a gain of 13. However, the average on board strength for USMC officers during the month was only 35. The Battalion sustained 29 USMC WIA's and four KIA's.

2. Administration. Nothing significant.

3. Intelligence. The month of October was characterized by the completion of VC foodstuff gathering activities about 10 October; a slack period from 11 to about 20 October; a build-up of VC forces to achieve specific military aims commenced about 21 October to the end of the month. From 11 to 20 October it is assumed that the VC withdrew the majority of their forces in order to re-train and re-equip for their present military campaign in the 1/9 TACR.

a. Psychological Warfare. In order to combat VC political activities in the TACR, and also to exploit the technique of political indoctrination a vigorous campaign of psychological warfare has been adopted. The services of the RCA VANG Audio Team; the I Corps Audio Team and the 1st MAW psychological warfare helicopter have been employed with obvious inroads of success. The main theme of these techniques and the face to face persuasion conducted at the platoon level, through interpreters, has been to reiterate the need for cooperation with GVN and USMC forces.

b. Special Operations. None.

c. Employment of AN/TPS-21, SID/150, and the Infrared Sighting Device

(1) AN/TPS-21. The radar sets AN/TPS-21 were inoperable for about 20 days in October because of malfunctioning components. However, when operable they were used by the forward companies with negligible results.

(2) SID/150. These were employed without success for the period. The loose sandy soil of the TACR severely restricts the effectiveness of the SID/150.

(3) Infrared Sighting Device. These were employed without success throughout the period.

4. Training. The 60mm mortars were placed in service for tactical employment on 17 October 1965, all companies having completed the required training.

5. Special Operations. Nothing significant.

6. Nuclear, Biological, Chemical, and other Special Types of Warfare. Nothing significant.

12. Air Defense. Nothing significant.

13. Combat Air Support. Nothing significant.

14. Medical and Dental Support. In addition to routine sick call this month, several combat casualties were treated. One group from the Sorwar area and another from a land mine on the night of 28 October were the significant casualties treated in the BAS. Many local civilian personnel were given emergency treatment and referred to the civilian hospital in DI HANG.

People to people program was conducted an average of three times a week with the corpsman from Battery "D", 2d Bn, 12th Marines assisting.

We have had a moderate amount of dysentery during the last month. FMS has been notified.

Lectures on VD and general sanitation were conducted for the letter companies on 8 and 9 October.

1st Battalion, 9th Marines had its first corpsman evacuated because of combat wounds on 13 October. HIN STONE received a missile wound of the shoulder and was evacuated to USNH, Guam.

On 25 October the VC attacked the local Village Chief's house wounding him and several members of his family. Arrangements were made by the Battalion Surgeon to obtain medical treatment at "C" Med for the Chief. His family is now being housed within the CE area and treated as outpatients by the Battalion Surgeon.

The Battalion Aid Station completed a medical bunker and trenches for self protection. The Seabees completed the Battalion Aid Station hard backs on 17 October. The Battalion Aid Station is now housed in three hard backs (one for BAS, one for records section and HM1 quarters, and one for E-5 and below quarters). Medical supply is located in one GP tent with only a wooden deck, which is considered adequate at this time.

Other than the routine problems of supply, no other major problems have occurred.

15. Chaplain Support. During October, moral guidance lectures were given by the Chaplain to two line companies. Company "D" was visited in the field. Two memorial services were held with a combined attendance of 225 men. Special sermons were prepared for "Laymen's Sunday" and "United Nations Day." Regular church parties left the Battalion area for Jewish, Latter Day Saints, and Christian Science church services.

16. Civil Affairs. During the month of October the Battalion concentrated its civic action effort in the area of ECA LONG Village.

MedCap treatment was given three times weekly in the hamlet of NUI KIE (BT 973704).
